This is the centre of our week at St. George's and our main service. It lasts approximately 75 minutes with hymns, a sermon and incense. During this service we have our Choir, the Sunday School for the children and the Crèche for the young ones.

Twice a month the Malagasy community meets for the Eucharist in Malagasy.

About our preacher—The Very Rev'd Andrew Nunn: I am so looking forward to being part of Holy Week at St George's Paris in 2024.
